Key Programs and Services

- Matching and referral of individuals to job openings for which they are qualified. In addition, the **Kentucky's Job Bank** at www.ajb.org/ky and **America's Job Bank** at www.ajb.org allow job seekers to search for jobs locally, regionally or nationally. Employers can use the **on-line job order** to post their openings.
- Training and employment services are available to adults, youth and dislocated workers through the **OET Offices** and **One-Stop Career Centers**.
- Assistance through the **Rapid Response** service for employers who are laying off workers or anticipating a business closure. Rapid response provides information about retraining, job opportunities, filing for unemployment insurance benefits, and other local, state and federal services to the employees facing layoff.
- **Unemployment Insurance** benefits are available to workers who are temporarily unemployed through no fault of their own. Job search and job placement services are available to individuals receiving UI benefits. Claimants may **file for benefits** by telephone (502-875-0442) or on-line. Employers may register for accounts and file and pay their **quarterly contributions** on line. On-line services are available at www.kewes.ky.gov.
- Career information, employment projections, Unemployment Insurance data, unemployment rates, wage data and other **workforce information** to serve employers, job seekers, educators, economic developers and training providers is available through www.workforcekentucky.ky.gov
- Employment assessment, job readiness training, job search, work experience, and job placement assistance to **eligible individuals** participating in the Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program.
- State and federal income **tax credits** are available to employers who hire eligible individuals.
- Assistance for agricultural employers in recruiting **migrant and seasonal farm** workers and in complying with state and federal laws regarding their employment. Initial case development to certify aliens to work in **non-agricultural**, temporary or seasonal, positions that could not be filled by qualified U. S. Citizens.
- Resource rooms in Employment and Training/One Stop offices equipped with materials and tutorials on resume writing, interviewing, job searching and maintaining a job.
- Specialized assistance for qualified **veterans** and other eligible individuals.
